"Half a Sixpence" is a typically English musical comedy based on the novel "Kipps" by H.G.Wells. It's a high kicking, heel clicking show that leaves you smiling and humming the very catchy tunes.

It was originally created for Tommy Steele, a 60s rock star, who also made it into a successful film, with hit songs like "Flash, Bang, Wallop" and "Money to burn". More recently it was revived by Cameron Mackintosh where it had a long stay in the West End when understudy Charlie Stemp took up the role of Kipps to massive acclaim, winning numerous awards.



It tells the story of a young draper's assistant who inherits a fortune which propels him into high society. It turns everything he thought he knew about life upside down. He's torn between all the good things money can buy and the love of his down to earth childhood sweetheart.

The show is performed by Bristol Musical Youth Productions, a multi-award winning company that's been presenting top quality musical theatre with young people for over 35 years.
